## WEEKLY UPDATE – KEVIN WADE FOR SENATE CAMPAIGN

### MONDAY, January 16 – Campaign Victory Meeting

--Kevin Wade spoke with supporters during a Representative District 35 meeting in Greenwood, Delaware. Wade spoke about America not being able to heal until Washington is fixed. He said, "Washington can't fix itself. It is up to us, *We The People*, to fix what's broken by sending new voices to do the hard work."

### TUESDAY, January 17 - Rally for the Future

--At a gathering at the Geneva Academy in Lincoln, Delaware, Wade discussed his vision for Delaware and stressed the importance of quality education during a lively meeting with community leaders and supporters in Sussex County's Representative District 36. School director James Dundas said Wade "...was well spoken and received enthusiastically by the people here; I think he can make it all the way if people step up with their support. We definitely need new leadership in Washington."

### WEDNESDAY, January 18 – Let's Get Started Meet-up

--Campaign chairs and volunteers from New Castle, Kent and Sussex counties met in Dover to discuss strategy, organization and 'boots on the ground' activities. Kevin said Senator Carper is running one more tired re-election campaign. He ended by saying this our team is not running a seasonal political campaign, but a "Rescue Mission" for our children's futures.

### FRIDAY, January 20 – Bruce Elliott Show, WILM-AM 1450 Radio.

--Elliott and Wade broadcast from Arners Diner in New Castle. They held a lively discussion regarding the latter's plans and vision for Delaware in contrast to now-Senator Tom Carper's business as usual cronyism. Particularly noted was Carper's silence on the administration's denial of the XL Keystone Pipeline extension. Wade and Elliott discussed real-world ideas for job creation vs. Carper's tired talking points as a rubber-stamp for Washington after 35 years in government on the tax payer's payroll.
